

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR LOCAL ADOPTION



- Original Birth Certificate(s) of the child/children
- Copies of Birth Certificate(s) of applicant(s) and a photo ID
- Copies of *Birth Certificate(s)* of the child's biological parent(s)
- Original Death Certificate(s) of the child's biological parent(s) (if applicable)
- Copies of Marriage Certificate(s) of applicant(s) (if applicable)
- Copies of Marriage Certificate(s) of the child's biological parent(s) (if applicable)
- ➤ **Police clearance** (Clearance should be current and not older than 6 months at the time of the Adoption Board hearing.)

➤ Medical Report

✓ Note: medicals for children must be completed by a registered Paediatrician.

> Two written character references

- ✓ Not to be completed by relatives of the child or Applicants.
- ✓ Must include information regarding the Applicant(s) personality and parenting capacity.
- ✓ Must know the Applicant for at least one year.
- ✓ Address and contact number of referees.
- ➤ **Affidavit of Support** -The person identified is required to submit an affidavit indicating his/her willingness to care for the child in the event the Applicant becomes incapable of fulfilling their responsibilities as parent.

It must include:

- ✓ Name and signature of the person who agrees to be the support network.
- ✓ If the support network is married, the spouse must also attach their name and signature.
- ✓ Age/Date of birth
- ✓ Address
- ✓ Occupation
- ✓ Salary/earnings
- ✓ Their child's; names and age/ date of birth (if applicable)
- ✓ Must clearly state that they agree to the responsibility of caring for the child in the event the Applicant is unavailable.
- > Original Job letter(s)/ proof of financial status of applicant(s) or contract of employment if available.
- Copy of child's school report (if applicable)

Please note: In addition to the copies of documents mentioned above, the Applicant is asked to submit the original documents for verification. *Contact us on the numbers listed, if you have any questions.*
